Magali is a young french canadian artist that already has gained a name on the international scope. Research and experimentation are the source of her creations. Driven by the desire to contribute to the field of contemporary jewellery, but also to transform and change it, her artistic statement is based on the research of emotions through form and color. Self-taught and trained by her artist parents, she also graduated from the Jewellery School of Montreal, in 2013.
